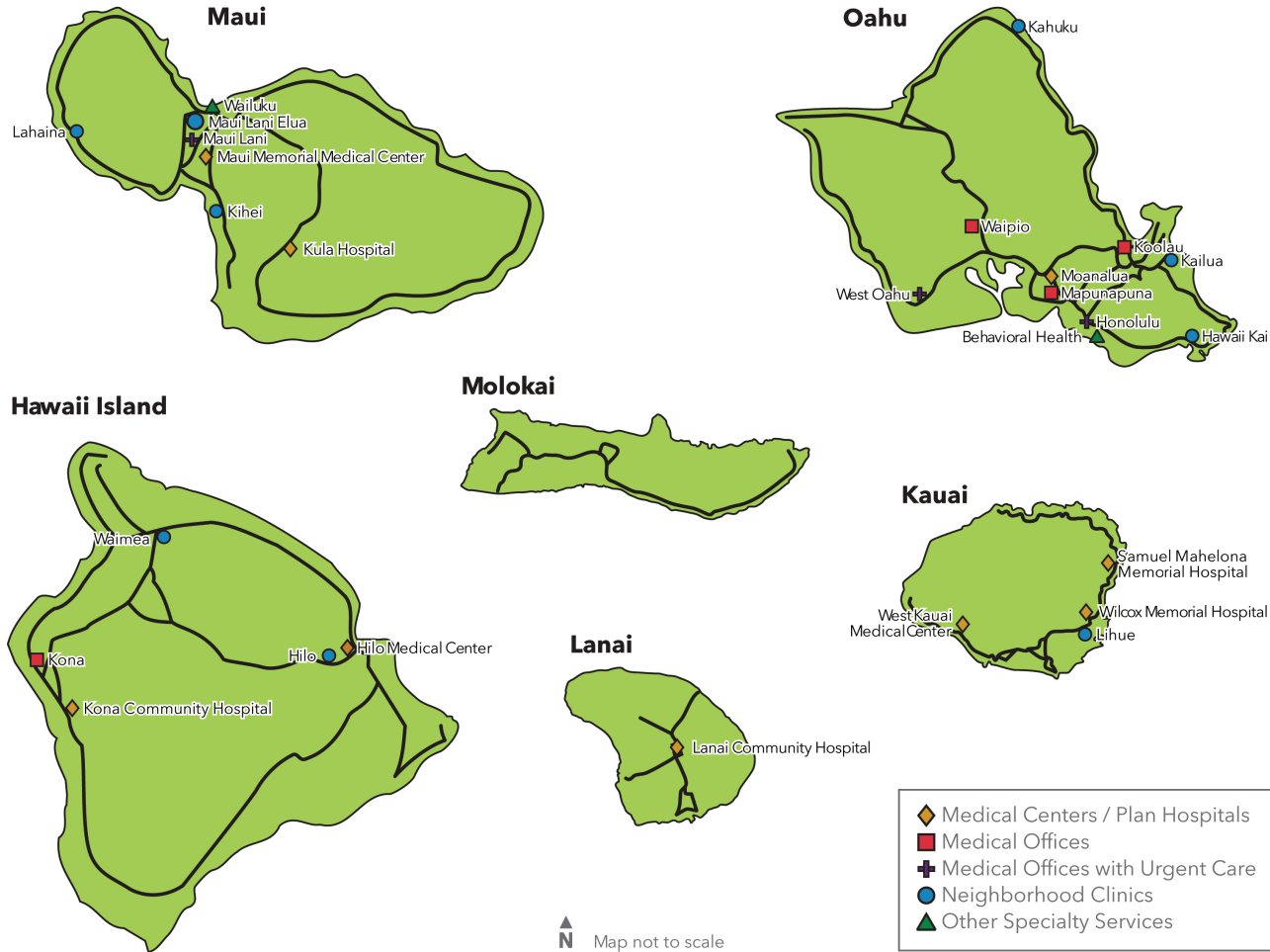


Find a location near you

Urgent care in Hawaii

If you need urgent care outside of normal business hours, you can visit a Kaiser Permanente or contracted urgent care facility at the same cost of a regular office visit.⁹ Visit [kp.org/getcare](https://www.kp.org/getcare) for a list of facilities in your area.

Urgent and emergency care outside Hawaii

With Kaiser Permanente, you have coverage for emergency and urgent care anywhere in the world.

If you need urgent care **in a Kaiser Permanente service area**, visiting members can go to the nearest Kaiser Permanente urgent care clinic.^{10,11}

If you need urgent care **in a state without Kaiser Permanente**, go to the nearest urgent care provider, including Cigna PPO Network providers, MinuteClinic® locations, including pharmacies (in select CVS and Target stores), Concentra Urgent Care centers, or The Little Clinic locations, including pharmacies.^{12,13}

Dependent children, including college students, also have coverage for certain routine and follow-up primary care when Kaiser Permanente facilities aren't near. Visiting member benefits apply when living in other Kaiser Permanente service areas.

If you need urgent care **while traveling internationally**, go to the nearest urgent care facility or hospital.¹⁴

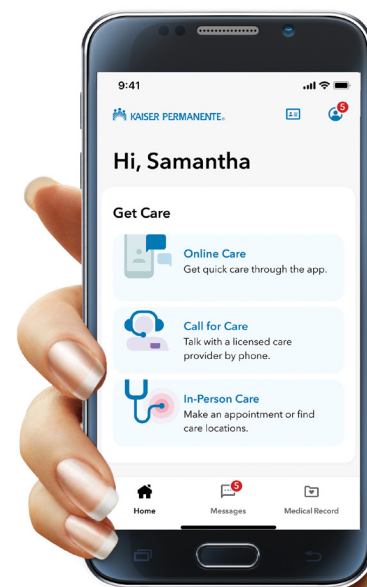

Utilization management

The medical care and services provided or authorized by a physician are subject to utilization management (UM) review. UM describes the various methods that ensure you receive the right care, at the right time, in the right place by reviewing hospital admissions, referred services, and post-service claims and providing care management services for certain medical conditions to help you maintain your health at the highest level possible. If we deny your request for payment or coverage during the UM review, you have the right to file an appeal and ask that we reconsider our decision. You may be covered for medically necessary urgent care when you are temporarily outside of the country if the care can't be delayed until you get back home. Medicaid members are not covered. 15. Long-distance charges may apply, and we cannot accept collect calls. The phone line is closed on major holidays (New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, July Fourth, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas). It closes early the day before a holiday at 10 p.m. Pacific time (PT), and it reopens the day after a holiday at 4 a.m. PT. 16.
